Instructions:

Step 1. I like to save wire, so I put all my beads onto the wire while still on the spool.

Step 2 .Begin by stringing 1 of the F-PW-BDCP-4BEAD-AG (beadcaps) followed by the Swarovski Crystal and faced by another beadcap, the pattern is repeating, so continue with the faceted spacer bead, one of the Zanfirico discs, another faceted spacer bead and another beadcap, crystal, beadcap and then one of the 4mm Heishi which will go on either side of the 14mm disc. .



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Step 3. Continue this pattern through to the end. Measure the length at this point, knowing that the clasp will add about ½ inch additional. If you need to make it longer, add more of the Swarovski Crystals. Alternatively, if you need to shorten, eliminate the two ending Swarovski Crystals which will take about ½ inch out.

Step 4. When you have the length you need, run the loose end of your wire, 1) through the crimp bead 2) through the wire protector 3) Add one piece of the toggle clasp into the opening in the wire protector 4) Run the wire back through the crimp bead. I like to run it back through the first bead as I like the way it looks. Pull this together snugly and Crimp the Crimp bead. Then trim the loose end of the wire close.

Step 5. Slide all your beads and findings up against this completed end of the bracelet and cut the wire giving yourself about 2-3 inches for working.

Then repeat the **Step 4** above again, this time adding the other side of the toggle.
