



4 Strands Red and Black Bracelet

Make this bracelet and enjoy its patterns and the multi strand. It features all authentic Murano Glass and our sparkle line of beads in the pebble shape.

Use this design with any of our other colors. This makes an approximately 8.5 inch bracelet.

SKILL: Stringing/Crimping

Tools:

Side Cutter, & Crimp Tool, Flat Nose Pliers

Want it Longer or Shorter?

If you need more length, add additional beads between the 4 strands and the closure. If you need to shorten, it is best to reduce the 4 strands as you need the space by the clasp to work. Decrease evenly on each row the opaque round 6mm

Murano Glass beads, for each 4 you will decrease approximately 1 inch.



Instructions:

Step 1. Cut 4 strands of beading wire approximately 12 inches in length. String each of the 4 rows as shown. Using bead stoppers to hold in place.



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Step 2 String onto each of the strands (we'll start on the right side) a crimp bead, and then wrap the wire around one of the 4mm Closed Jump Rings and pull tightly and crimp, cut the wire closely so it isn't exposed. (I like to run the wire back through a couple of beads, not for security, but because I don't like the look of a wire cut close to the crimp.)

Step 4. Take the 4 strands and do a slight plait, crossing rows over giving it a twisted appearance. Then Repeat Step 2 for each of the rows the left side, being sure to pull the beads tightly.

Step 5. Finishing the bracelet, adding the end caps and clasp. This is the tricky part. Cut 2 pieces of wire about 5 inches. Attach one of the wires to the 4mm jump ring which has the 4 strands attached. Crimp this and cut. Slide on the end cap, (the crimp will slide through, you will cover this later with a crimp cover, but don't worry about it now) Add 2 of the 6mm rounds.

Step 6. Add a crimp bead, and string the wire through the wire protector, slide the closed loop of your lobster clasp inside the wire protector and pull the wire back through the crimp bead (again, I take back through at least one bead) and cut closely.

Step 7. For the other side, do the same as Step 6, but use the 7mm Closed Jump Ring which will be the ring where you close with the clasp.

Step 8. Add Crimp Bead Covers to the 2 crimps on each side of the bracelet. If your crimp beads do not extend through the end cap, there is no need for the Crimp Cover.
