



## 5 Strands Vicenza Red Gold and Silver Bracelet

Make this bracelet and enjoy its patterns and the multi strand. It features all authentic Murano Glass Vicenza Gold and Silver Beads and our solid color matching bold Red rounds.

Use this design with any of our other colors.

This makes an approximately 7 3/4 inch bracelet.

**SKILL: Stringing/Crimping**

**Tools:**

Side Cutter, & Crimp Tool, Flat Nose Pliers

**Supplies:** 018 or.019 Wire about 60 Inches

**Want it Longer or Shorter?**

If you need more length, add additional beads between the 4 strands and the closure. If you need to shorten, it is best to reduce the strands as you need the space by the

clasp to work. Decrease evenly on each row the opaque round 6mm Murano Glass beads.

### Instructions:

**Step 1.** Cut 4 strands of beading wire approximately 12 inches in length. String each of the 4 rows as shown. Using bead stoppers to hold in place. The 3mm rondelles go on each side of the Vic beads (the ones decorated with Gold and Silver and at the ends of each of the 4 strands with these beads.



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**Step 2** The strand with the seedbead and the silver foil beads, we lace through the other 4 strands and begin with it in the top left of the connector and the other end is at the bottom right of the opposite connector for a little extra interest..



**Step 4.** Using the crimp tubes, thread them on the wire, then thread through the loop on the connector and back through the crimp tube, pulling snugly. I always send the wire through the first couple of beads, but you can cut right at the tube.

**Step 5.** Do the same on the opposite end of your strands.

**Step 6.** Use the 6mm jump ring to attach the clasp to each end of the bracelet.
