This pastel shades bracelet is perfect for spring and summer

Length: 7 Inches

Ways to Lengthen:

To add ½ inch, add 2 8mm beads
 To add 1 ¼ inch add 4 8mm beads
 (Alternating colors to the design)
 Add chain extension.

Tools:

Side Cutters
 Flat Nose Pliers

Wire: ~12-14 Inches of 019

Instructions:

Step 1. Begin by cutting your wire. I actually prefer to use it off the end of my spool to save those couple of inches.

Step 2. If you cut the wire you can begin in the center and string from each side. Since I string directly onto the spool of wire, I begin at one end and string. (I have already laid it out on my beading board for sizing.)

Step 3. Use a bead cap before and after each bead and follow the picture above for bead placement.

Step 4. To complete the bracelet follow the instructions below:



Step 5. If you have strung this on the spool, then cut the wire about 3-5 Inches longer than the bracelet and follow the instructions for the opposite end of the toggle. Gently tighten the bracelet before crimping the crimp tube and finally cut the extra wire.

Tips:

I like to run my wire back through the first beadcap and through the bead. I know that the wire makers say this is not necessary, but I like the security

When adding length, add 2 beadcaps for each bead.
