



Gold and Chain

LEVEL: Beginner/Intermediate
This is not hard, just requires a little more time and wire wraps.

Tools:

Side Cutter, Wire Wrapping Pliers.

The instructions are for an approximately 18 Inch Necklace. If you would like longer, it is easy to add more links of chain to elongate it.

Components

| GL-CLSP-MN-5L | 1 | Boro Glass Toggle Clasp 20mm, Light Topaz |
| OVAL-16X8-G1 | 6 | Clear 24kt Gold Foil Ovals 16x8mm Murano Glass Beads |
| RN-14-G1 | 6 | Clear 14mm Gold Foil Round Venetian Glass Bead |

Step 1. Make the longer strand first. Begin by cutting (2) 4 link sections (for the ends closest to the clasp. Cut (6) 3 link sections. Working from the 1st 4 link section, using the 180A-020 Gold Wire (you will need a total of 14 pieces of wire approximately 1 ½ inches and 2 pieces of 2 Inches. Wire wrap the one 14mm Gold Foil Bead between the 4 link section and one 3 link section of chain. Repeat this. And then wire wrap one Oval Gold Foil Bead, followed by one Bicone Gold Foil Bead. Then wire wrap one additional 3 link section, with the center being another 14mm Gold Foil Bead. Then repeat this in reverse until you have added the 4 link section. Set aside.

Step 2. Now assemble the shorter strand. Cut (2) 12 link sections, and (2) 3 link sections. Wire wrap the Bicone to one of the 12 link sections, followed by the oval and then a 3 link section arriving at the center of this strand which is the 14mm Gold Foil Round. Then continue in reverse.

Step 3. To assemble the necklace. Wire Wrap one side of both the strands into a single wire wrap and then add to your Wire the oval Gold Foil Bead, and on the other end of the oval, wire wrap the clasp. (Note you could use a metal clasp, we used our Boro Glass Clasp. If you use the Glass Clasp, be sure you make a larger wire wrap to accommodate the size of the glass clasp. Do the same for the other end of your strands.
