



# Gold Foil and Bling Murano Necklace

This necklace is simplicity and beauty all together. The matted Murano Glass 24kt Gold Foil Beads are enhanced by the Rondelles with Crystals.

You can make this necklace as long or short as you choose..

**Tools:**

Long Nose Pliers      Side Cutter

**Skill:** Crimping and Gluing

**Instructions:**

**Step 1** Follow the instructions on the Etchall and matte the gold foil beads. Dry them thoroughly, on a cloth, not a paper towel as the paper towel will adhere to the bead making more work for you.



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**Step 2** Cut the wire. We made a choker so our necklace is only 18 inches (always add about 2 inches longer than you want for room to work.

**Step 2** String the beads onto the wire, with the Eternity Rondelles between the 3 beads as shown..

**Step 3.** Center these beads on the wire. Slide the 1.6x1.0mm crimp on one end of the wire and push it snugly inserted slightly into the hole of the end Gold Foil Bead. Crimp the tube to secure the beads.

**Step 4.** Slide on the 5mm Rondelle and Glue it in place against the Gold Foil Bead, this hides the crimp you just used.

**Step 5.** Repeat Step 3 and 4 above for the other side of the 3 beads.

**Step 6.** Finish the necklace off by running the wire through the crimp tube, around the Jump Ring (be sure it is closed securely) and back through the crimp tube. Crimp the tube and place the crimpbead over it and close securely.

**Step7.** Do the same for the other side using the lobster clasp. Again be sure the ring is closed securely..

If you wish, you could add a wire protector which keeps the wire from having a tight bend.

### Longer or Shorter?

If you need it shorter the easiest thing to do is to lengthen or shorten the wire
