



Lucky Irish Twist Necklace

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

Tools:

Side Cutter

Wire Wrapping Pliers

Adjusting for You:

This instructions makes a necklace which is 18 inches (~45cm). If you want it longer, you will need to increase the length equally of all chain sections.

If you prefer Silver, then you may substitute all the metal components for Silver.

Components :

Instructions:

Step 1. Cut 8 lengths of chain 2 ¾ inch or 65mm in length (For the extender, you will need a section of chain 2 Inches long)

Step 2. With your 22 gauge wire, insert through the Venetian Glass Twist and wire wrap one end of your cut chain. With the other end of the wire, wire wrap to a second section of your chain. You will need 4 pieces. The last of the 4, leave the end of the bead unfinished until you complete the second set of 4 links.

Step 3. Wire Wrap the Swarovski Bicones to the chain, We balanced them between the beads but you may adjust to wherever you prefer.

Step 4. Wire the last twist which you left open to the last ring on your second chain. Then Wire Wrap the remaining end to the other end of the chain.

Step 5. Now you will begin wire wrapping the Swarovski Bicones for the balance of the necklace. Here if you wish, you can also increase the length. We wire wrapped 3 of the 4mm bicones in a row before adding the clasp

Step 6. Wire Wrap the last 3mm Bicone to your clasp on one end and to your extender chain length on the other.
