



Pastel Rounds Spring Necklace



Mother-Daughter Easy Project
 Just 2 Tools
 Beading Wire
 Clasp
 Beadcaps

What could be easier. You can make this necklace in under 20 minutes. It's a great Mother-Daughter project which will get the younger ones into beading without frustration.

We used 14mm beads in this necklace, but you can easily change out with smaller beads for a Mother-Daughter set.

Begin by cutting a length of your wire which is 3-4 inches longer than the length of the necklace you want. Take one end, and slide on (1) of your crimp beads. Then slip through the jumping on the spring ring, around and through your crimp bead. This will secure the wire to the spring ring closure.

Add one bead cap on each side of your beads. It's best to lay out the colors in a line the way you want to place them. We used a total of 23 beads, (see note below) which requires 46 beadcaps

When you get to the last bead repeat the step above for the crimp bead to the other side of your spring ring. Cut the wire close to the crimp bead.



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Note: BeadCaps shown are sold in packs of 10 so for 23 beads, you'll need 5 packs. Use the extra ones to make earrings by adding 2 beads of the color you choose.

Modifications:

Bead Sizes: Remember 25mm equals 1 inch.

So if you want a 16 inch necklace using 10mm beads you will need approximately 36-40 beads. We say a few less because your clasp takes up about 15mm.

How to Calculate the Quantity of Beads for a Project

You can calculate the quantity you need by

_____ Inches X 25 = _____mm / the size of your bead.

Example:

16 Inches X 25mm = 400 mm/ 10mm bead = 40 beads
