Get ready for spring with this colorful Picasso design.

Length: 7.5 Inches

If you need longer, add 6mm rounds at the each end of the bracelet. To shorten, use 6mm rounds, or delete beads from each end.

Other Ways to Lengthen:

Add larger clasp/toggle

Use a clasp and add chain extension.

Tools:

Side Cutters

Crimping Tool

Needle Nose Pliers

Wire: ~12-14 Inches of 019

Instructions:

Step 1. Begin by cutting your wire. I actually prefer to use it off the end of my spool to save those couple of inches.

Step 2. If you cut the wire you can begin in the center and string from each side. Since I string directly onto the spool of wire, I begin at one end and string. (I have already laid it out on my beading board for sizing.)

Step 3. Use a bead cap before and after each bead and follow the picture above for bead placement. Around the 8mm beads use the smaller bead cap, on the pebbles, use the larger.

Step 4. To finish the bracelet, slide the wire through the crimp bead, around the wire protector. Insert the clasp into the inside of the wire protector (looks like a horse shoe) and then slide the wire back through the same crimp bead. Pull the wire snug to the clasp, crimp the crimp bead and slide the wire through the bead cap. I always cut the wire after the first bead. Then cut the wire close to the bead.

Step 5. Do the same on the opposite end, this time using the closed jump ring, then crimp. Pull the wire snugly and cut the excess.
