A simple design using our incredible Porcelain Painted Flowers on Murano Glass Beads.

Length (without extension) 18 1/2 Inches

Tools:

- Side Cutter
- Flat Nose Pliers
- Crimping Pliers

Supplies:

Beading Wire (.018 or .019)

NOTES:

This necklace is best strung from the center bead out.

There are 16 seed beads between each of the focal beads and the next round bead.

The extension chain is optional
You could use a closed jumpring like:

Instructions:

1. If you cut your wire before stringing, you will need about 25 inches.
2. Beginning with the center bead. Put one beadcap on each side of the center bead (see photo).
3. The diagram below shows the placement of the beadcaps and the silver rondelles.
4. Finish the necklace as shown in the second photo.



- Remember to string the crimp tube onto the wire before you string it through the wire protector. See the photo below for a better idea of how to crimp.
