LEVEL: Beginner

This is an easy bracelet to make, it uses our solid color Murano Glass Beads and our lampwork rings. We have many colors of these two components, so make up your own design.

Tools:

Crimping Tool, Wire Cutter.

Components

The supplies for each bracelet are listed below. If you have wire in your beading basket, you can use it. We recommend the .024 (approximately as it is good for glass beads.)

Black and Topaz Ring A'Round Bracelet

Red Ring A'Round Bracelet

Instructions: The same for both earrings

Step 1. Cut a length of wire about 5 inches longer than your wrist. .

Step 2. Insert the crimp on to your wire, thread the wire through the wire protector, slide one side of your toggle clasp into the center of the wire protector. Make sure you have a short length of wire and slide the crimp over the ends of the two wires. Using your crimping tool, close the crimp, tug on it to be sure it is secure.

Step 3. Alternating beginning with a round bead, followed by a glass ring. As these are all handmade, some beads as well as rings may be slightly larger or smaller. Choose the ring that is slightly smaller than the bead.

Step 4. Following the instructions in Step 1, do the same with the other end of the toggle clasp. I like to send my wire back through at least the first bead, it is not necessary, I just like the way it looks.
