



Silver “Y” Drop Necklace

Make a drop necklace for your own.. .



You could use any combination of beads you like, to change the tone. We worked with the neutral colors of Silver and Gray.

Tools: Wire Looping Pliers, Needle Nose Pliers & Side Cutter

Skill Level: Basic Beginner

Skill Required: Wire Wrapping

Items Required:

2ft F-SS-CHBEL10, 2.4mm Sterling Silver Rolo Chain

2 RN-12-S1 Crystal Silver Foil Round

2 RN-12-S10L Light Steel Silver Foil Round

2 F-SS-LJR4, .925 Sterling Silver Locking Jump Ring, 4mm, Per Piece

1 F-SS-CL-LOBR-5090, Sterling Silver Trigger Clasp 9mm w/Ring. Per Piece

6 F-SS-HP222, 2 Inch Sterling Silver Headpin, 22ga, Per Piece (You could use wire instead of the headpins, they are just cut to a good length for wire wrapping.)

1 F-SS-HP1524BE, . 1 1/2 Inch Sterling Silver Headpin 24ga, Ball End (This is for the last bead on the end of the “Y”).

Instructions:

Make the individual sections of the necklace and then assemble.

Begin by cutting the chain in preparation

(2) 4 inch lengths of the chain

(4) 2 inch lengths of the chain

(2) 1 ½ inch lengths

Take the locking jump ring and attach the Trigger Clasp to one of the lengths of chain.

With a headpin, wire wrap one side to the end of this length of chain.

On the other side of the bead, cut the head of the pin off and wire wrap it to one of the 2 inch lengths of chain, followed by a second bead positioned the same.

When you have the two upper sides of the “Y” completed, add the center bead and attach both the ends of your “Y” into the wire loop. On the lower side of this bead, attach one of the 1 ½ inch lengths and another bead, joining the last piece of chain in the dangle.

For the final bead, use the headpin with the Ball End as this will finish off your necklace nicely.

To make the necklace longer, add more chain in the lengths directly attached to the clasp. To make it shorter, you can cut a shorter piece of chain. It is better to increase or decrease the length proportionately so that the center of the “Y” is symmetrical.



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Alternatives:

Change the colors or use Gold Fill Chain and Gold Foil Beads, here are some suggestions
