This bracelet features the Pantone Colors for Spring 2016 and the Colors of the Year. Rose Quartz & Serenity.

Tools:

Side Cutter, & Chain Nose Pliers

Make it Longer or Shorter:

This makes a 7 Inch Bracelet. If you need it shorter, eliminate a couple of beads. For longer, continue the pattern of the last beads on the ends, adding equally to each side.

SUPPLIES:

Wire for stringing - Use your favorite.
We used WS-STW02410SLV

Instructions:

Step 1. Cut a length of wire approximately 4 inches longer than the bracelet, (so about 1 foot). I am thrifty with the wire, so I string on the wire while still on the spool, finishing off one end, before cutting, which saves you about 2 inches each bracelet.

Step 2. String the beads as shown, since it is symmetrical you can start in the middle. I lay it out on a beading board and then start from one end (so I can save the wire as described in Step 1 above).

Step 3. Be sure to add the crimp bead, then run the wire through the wire protector, insert the swivel clasp into the horseshoe then run the wire back through the crimp bead. I like to run the wire through the first couple of bead. Cut the wire so it does not protrude from the bracelet.

Step 4. On the other end follow the instructions from Step 3 inserting the closed jump ring, cut the wire closely.
